Beware, when the tribulation does come they will say: “...My lord delayeth his coming; and shall begin to beat the menservants and maidens, and to eat and drink, and to be drunken.” [Luke 12:45]</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>We have not added or taken away from the scriptures Touch not, taste not, handle not, commanding to abstain from meats,, [Col 2:20-23][I Tim 4:3]. God will deal with those that add or take away from His Word [Rev 22:18-19]. One example is taking the view of some that say the world wasn't created in an actual six days, detracting from the power/word of God. [Gen 2:2-3] The flowers and fruit trees couldn't have waited a thousand years for the bees and other pollinators to show up.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>We have not turned the grace of the only one true God, the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob into lasciviousness (permission to sin) [Jude 1:4]. There is a difference between stumbling and continuing in sin.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>We have not changed the fear of God into just a reverence for God “The fear of God is the beginning of wisdom, “...The fear of the Lord is a fountain of life to depart from the snares of death”, “Serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear: for our God is a consuming fire”, and “it is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.” [Psalm 111:10, Proverbs 14:27, Deuteronomy 5:29, Hebrew 12:28-29, Hebrew 10:31]</p>
